Rev. Green deliver foot-stomping blues, folk, Americana and spirituals—up-tempo, familiar, and built for rooms that love to sing along.

Band Bio (Short)

Rev. Green are a seasoned **four / five-piece acoustic band** rooted in blues, folk, Americana and spirituals. Known for their warm stagecraft and driving rhythms, they turn festivals, pubs, clubs and community halls into sing-along spaces. Their sets balance well-loved standards with characterful originals, keeping the energy high and the atmosphere welcoming.

Band Bio (Long)

Formed in March 2024 and based in Wimborne, **Rev. Green** bring together five experienced musicians with deep roots in the UK folk and acoustic scene. Their sound blends blues grit, folk storytelling, Americana grooves and spirituals—usually up-tempo and immediately accessible.

The band features **Steve Utley** (vocals, mandolin, mandocello, tenor guitar), **Jeremy Green** (vocals, guitar, bouzouki), **Nat Morris (occasionally)** (vocals, banjo, tenor banjo, guitar), **Andy Bridgeman** (vocals, bass) and **Jayne Chalke** (percussion and drums), combining driving rhythm with rich acoustic texture.

Rev. Green have played at venues and events including **The Old Thatch, The Oddfellows Arms, The Tap House, Brunny Folk, Allendale Café Sessions, Wimborne Folk Festival**, and **Wimborne Food Festival**, alongside regular local showcases.

With a reputation for engaging audiences and reading the room, Rev. Green are as comfortable leading a packed pub chorus as they are delivering a listening-room set. Between them, the five members bring decades of live performance, recording, touring and production experience, creating a band grounded in musicianship, professionalism and genuine love for the craft.
